## Location

The Sainsbury Centre for Visual Arts is situated on the University of East Anglia (UEA) campus, on the west side of Norwich.

## Buses

Numbers 22, 25, 26 and 27 run from Norwich city centre to UEA – ask for the Sainsbury Centre stop. For timetables, visit First Eastern at [www.firstgroup.com](http://www.firstgroup.com) or, for national bus timetable enquiries, call 0870 608 2608.

## Parking

A dedicated Sainsbury Centre car park (P7) is free of charge on a first-come, first-served basis to gallery visitors displaying a valid Sainsbury Centre parking permit, available free from Gallery Reception with your ticket.

Sainsbury Centre visitors may also park free of charge, if they display a valid Sainsbury Centre parking permit, in:

- the Sainsbury Centre visitor spaces along Norfolk Road (just beyond P7 on the left-hand side)
- the central car park (P5)
- the north and west car parks (P2/3), which are available for visitors every weekend and outside university teaching periods (14 June to 21 September and from 13 December to 11 January inclusive)

There are four disabled parking spaces outside the Sainsbury Centre (see map) for visitors with mobility difficulties.

Other parking is in the UEA main car park (P1). This operates on

a pay-on-foot basis and Sainsbury Centre parking permits are not valid. Charges are displayed at the pay-on-foot machines.

**Please note that during term time UEA car parks are busiest on weekday mornings – spaces are easier to find at weekends and in the afternoon.**

UEA is striving to be a low carbon campus. Please come by public transport, on foot or by bike if you can. There are bike racks outside the Centre and covered bike racks between P3 and the Medical School.
